\*Illicit substances such as marijuana are not part of this initiative. Injectable, IV solutions, inhalers and other compressed air cylinders will not be accepted.

\*Sharps and needles will be accepted as long as they are in a rigid puncture resistant container and labeled sharps or biohazard. Some examples are, detergent jugs or fabric softener jugs, otherwise biohazard sharps containers are acceptable.

In a collaborative effort, Pathways Behavioral Services, the Buchanan County Sheriff's Office, and Buchanan County Health Center will be hosting a drop-off site for the DEA's 2015 National Take Back Day. This event is conducted in an effort to have patients and their families dispose of unwanted or expired medications. The National Take Back program is anonymous, and every effort will be made to protect the anonymity of individuals disposing of medications.
